When I started as a "baby youth minister" at Sacred Heart Parish in Sauk Rapids, the Diocese was organizing a trip to NCYC, the National Catholic Youth Conference in Indianapolis. Looking at the cost, and time, and feeling way out of my depth learning this new job, I had said we were going to pass for this year. After some 'convincing' from my youth ministry team and other staff members, we ended up attending that year. What I, and our high schoolers, experienced was a beautiful and inspiring view of the larger church: incredible speakers, great music, thought-provoking workshops. The community of believers is made all the more real to young people when they see a football stadium packed full of their peers that share the same faith.

Now, as Campus Ministry Director for our SCSU and SCTCC students, we have an opportunity to offer that to our college students as well at the National SEEK Conference, January 1st-5th, 2025, in Salt Lake City. SEEK25 is a gathering where thousands of young people come together to explore their faith, engage with inspiring speakers, and build a vibrant community. It's a chance for them to encounter Christ in a profound way and equip themselves to be leaders in our church.

To make this experience accessible for as many as possible, we're hosting a benefit dinner on Saturday, November 2nd at St. Anthony's parish here in St. Cloud. This space has the kitchen space we need and is a little closer for the CSBSJU students who will be traveling with us to Salt Lake City. This evening will be filled with a catered chicken dinner, uplifting stories, and the chance to connect with fellow parishioners who share a passion for nurturing the faith of the young church.
