The Easter Candle

For 51 years, my family and I have made the Easter Candle for the Newman Center. I'd like to share the story behind some of the wax that was included in this year's candle.

In Belfast, Ireland, 200 people gathered on April 14, Palm Sunday, at the slipway of Harland and Wolff, to light candles and spend two minutes of silence at 11:40 in the evening (marking the moment the Titanic hit the iceberg 107 years ago). In less than three hours, the Titanic sank, taking with it the lives of more than 1,500 men, women, and children. My son, Darian, was at the service and brought back to Minnesota the candle he had burned for those two minutes of silence. Wax from this candle has been melted down and is included in this year's Easter Candle. This year's Easter Candle also includes beeswax donated by Tom and Jodi Fischer's bees and from the Anniversary Candle marking 35 years of marriage between Chuck and Pat Ernst (now married 63 years!).
