Today we celebrate Sister Ange Mayer's 50th anniversary of professing her vows to serve the Lord as a Franciscan. The opening prayer for a Mass for this celebration goes like this:

O Lord, faithful God, grant, we pray, that we may give you thanks for the kindness towards our sister Ange, who today is eager to renew the gift received from you, strengthen in her a spirit of perfect charity, so that each day, she may more fervently serve your glory and the work of your salvation. Through Christ our Lord.

We see in this prayer how celebrating anniversaries helps us to focus our thanks on God for the gift of the vocation and to renew the sense that it is God whom we serve in charity. We compare this prayer to the prayer for a 40th anniversary of a marriage.

O God, Almighty Father, for the sake of the good works they have done through their long life together, look kindly on Joe and Pat (with the children they have brought to life and faith) and as you sealed the beginning of their love by a wonderful sacrament, so bless their fruitful old age. Through Christ our Lord.

In this prayer we see an echo of the teaching that through the love of the couple the love of God is revealed to the world in their love for each other, in their love extended to those in need and in their love extended to children and grandchildren. We also remember that it is the Lord who seals and guides this love in the world and into the future. Anniversaries are a special time of celebration for religious and married alike. Anniversaries allow us the opportunity to renew our prayer for the love of God to continue to be present and invited into each moment of our life.
