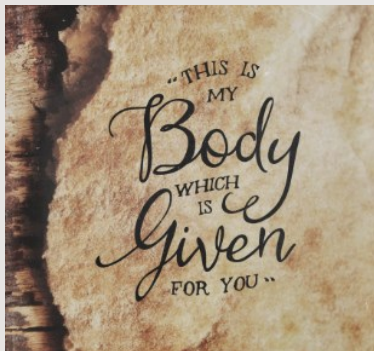

Today, Corpus Christi, we celebrate the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood. We rejoice as a community, called together to offer thanks to the one who gave his life for us, and to pray that our thoughts, words, and actions, might participate in the love Jesus has for each person.

I remember, as a girl, a period of time when I would watch the elements of bread and wine during the Eucharistic Prayer, sure that if I didn't blink I would see a visible act of God...maybe a beam of light from Heaven would strike through the roof of the Church and hit the bread and wine, transforming it into Jesus's Body and Blood. As time has passed, my focus has altered. The Eucharist for me is no longer about what changes God can make to bread and wine, but about how receiving Jesus in the form of his Body and Blood can change our lives.

As we gather today, we give thanks to God for his gift of the Eucharist. We also give thanks to LeRoy Zabel, who has been the maintenance director for some 30 years at the Newman Center. He has given of himself, shared his gifts and talents with our community, and been a part of our family. We are grateful for his service, and the way he has participated in the life of this Eucharistic community. We see in him the Body of Christ and we remember:

"Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks with compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which he blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are his body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours." -Teresa de Ávila
